

**SUMMER VILLAGE OF MA-ME-O BEACH
BYLAW NO. 339**

TO REGULATE ACTIVITIES IN JUBILEE PARK

BEING a Bylaw of the Summer Village of Ma-Me-O Beach, in the Province of Alberta, to regulate activities in Jubilee Park.

WHEREAS it is desirable to protect and maintain Jubilee Park in the Summer Village of Ma-Me-O Beach, and;

WHEREAS the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26, and amendments thereto, provides that Council may pass Bylaws for regulating people, activities and things in public places that are open to the public;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of Ma-Me-O Beach, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1.0 This Bylaw shall be known as the Regulate Activities in Jubilee Park Bylaw.

SECTION 2.0: DEFINITIONS

2.1 In this bylaw:

- a) "*Cooking*" means the use of Barbeques, Cook stoves, Fires or other heating or grilling devices to prepare food.
- b) "*Peace Officer*" means a Bylaw Enforcement Officer, or Community Peace Officer.
- c) "*Summer Village*" means the Summer Village of Ma-Me-O Beach .
- d) "*Violation Ticket*" means a form approved by the Summer Village, or a form prescribed by the *Provincial Offences Procedure Act*, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter P-34.

SECTION 2: OFFENCES

2.1 There shall be no cooking allowed in the Commemorative Brick area of Jubilee Park.

SECTION 3: PENALTIES

3.1 A peace officer authorized to enforce this Bylaw under Section 7 of the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26, and who has reasonable and probable grounds to believe that a person has contravened any section of this Bylaw, may under the authority of this Bylaw issue a Municipal tag, and where this tag is not paid by the offender, a Part 2 violation ticket may be issued under the *Provincial Offences Procedure Act*, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter P-34, to that person.

3.2 Anyone contravening this bylaw may be subject to a fine in the amount of \$100.00.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE

4.2 This Bylaw shall take effect on the date of the third and final reading.

Read a first time this 30th day of July, 2013.

Read a second time this 30th day of July, 2013.

Given unanimous consent to proceed to third reading this 30th day of July, 2013.

Read a third time and passed this 30th day of July, 2013.
