

## **SUMMER VILLAGE OF MA-ME-O BEACH**

### **BYLAW #336**

#### **A BYLAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF MA-ME-O BEACH IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO REGULATE THE STORAGE AND COLLECTION OF WASTE MATERIALS**

**WHEREAS** the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, and amendments thereto, provides that a municipality may pass bylaws for municipal purposes respecting services provided by the municipality; and

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Summer Village of Ma-Me-O Beach deems it desirable to establish standards for solid waste management.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Summer Village of Ma-Me-O Beach, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

#### **SECTION I: TITLE**

This Bylaw shall be known as “The Solid Waste Management Bylaw”

The purpose of this Bylaw is to establish standards of solid waste management, minimize waste management nuisances and set penalties relative to solid waste management.

#### **SECTION II: DEFINITIONS**

In this Bylaw:

“Householder” shall mean any owner, occupant, lessee, or tenant of any property.

“The Summer Village” shall mean the Summer Village of Ma-Me-O Beach.

“Oversize Items” shall mean heavy or bulky materials such as construction waste, renovation materials, furniture, concrete, and tree stumps.

“Special Fee Items” shall mean items identified by the Landfill site as requiring fees. This shall include but not be limited to propane tanks, appliances, and general waste over one ton.

“Waste Materials” shall mean waste generated from normal household operations, including but not limited to food waste, packaging, broken dishes, glass, rags, cast off clothing, papers, and other such materials normally generated in the process of daily living.

“Waste Collector” means the person or persons appointed or contracted by the Summer Village to collect and dispose of waste materials.

“Yard Waste” shall include yard maintenance and clean up waste such as grass clippings, tree branches, leaves and related materials which require special handling at the transfer station site.

“Uncollectible Materials” shall include oversize items, yard waste and special fee items.

### **SECTION III: REGULATIONS**

1. Every householder within the Summer Village shall provide at least one regulation size garbage container, either metal or plastic, with a tight fitting lid for the storage of waste materials.
2. Every householder shall also supply a suitable container stand with a lid in which the garbage container(s) shall be stored. This stand shall be designed to prevent animal access and prevent the cans from tipping over. The garbage stand shall be located along the garbage collection route in a manner that does not interfere with normal traffic such that the waste collector can obtain easy access.
3. All household waste materials shall be placed inside the garbage container in securely tied bags.
4. The weight of the garbage container and its contents shall not exceed 34 kg. (75 lb.).
5. The waste collector shall have the right to enter such portions and premises of all householders within the Summer Village as required for the purpose of performing the duties assigned to him as waste collector.
6. It is the responsibility of the householder to manage the disposal of Uncollectable Waste.
7. It is the responsibility of the waste collector to make collections and disposals of waste materials in accordance with the agreement between the waste collector and the Summer Village.

### **SECTION IV: OFFENCES AND PENALTIES**

1. Any person who contravenes any provisions of this Bylaw is, upon conviction guilty of an offence and is liable for a fine for each offense of not more than \$500.00.
2. A Bylaw Enforcement Officer, Peace Officer, or Special Constable is authorized to issue a Provincial Offences Procedure Act Violation Ticket.
3. Pursuant to the Provincial Offences Procedure Act, the person to whom the violation tag is issued may pay a specified penalty of \$50.00 to the Summer

Villages Office and if this amount is paid the person will not be prosecuted for the contravention.

4. If the Summer Village finds it necessary for the waste collector to clean up a garbage area, the homeowner will be charged \$50.00.

#### **SECTION V: COMING INTO FORCE**

This Bylaw comes into effect upon third and final reading.


Upon passing of this Bylaw, Bylaw #259 is hereby repealed.


Read a first time this 9<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2012.
