

**SUMMER VILLAGE OF MA-ME-O BEACH
BYLAW NO. 388**

**A BYLAW to AUTHORIZE the RATES of TAXATION
to be levied against ASSESSABLE PROPERTY within the
SUMMER VILLAGE of MA-ME-O BEACH, in the PROVINCE of ALBERTA,
for the 2022 TAXATION YEAR.**

WHEREAS, the Summer Village of Ma-Me-O Beach, in the Province of Alberta, has prepared and adopted detailed estimates of the municipal revenue and expenditures as required, at the Council meeting held on March 11, 2022;

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal revenues from all sources other than taxation are estimated at \$330,482; and

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal expenditures and transfers set out in the budget for the Summer Village of Ma-Me-O Beach, in the Province of Alberta, for 2022 total \$810,803 and the balance of \$480,321 to be raised by general municipal property taxation and;

THEREFORE, the total amount to be raised by general municipal taxation is \$480,321 and;

WHEREAS, the requisitions are:

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WHEREAS, Council of the Summer Village of Ma-Me-O Beach, in the Province of Alberta, is required each year to levy on the assessed value of all property tax rates sufficient to meet the estimated expenditures and requisitions; and

WHEREAS, Council is authorized to classify assessed property and to establish different rates of taxation in respect to each class of property, subject to the *Municipal Government Act*, Chapter M26, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000; and

WHEREAS, the assessed value of all property in the Summer Village of Ma-Me-O Beach, in the Province of Alberta, as shown on the assessment roll is:

NOW THEREFORE, under the authority of the *Municipal Government Act*, the Council of the Summer Village of Ma-Me-O Beach, in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- That the Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to levy the following rates of taxation on the assessed value of all property as shown on the assessment roll of the Summer Village of Ma-Me-O Beach, in the Province of Alberta:


- That the minimum municipal tax payable per lot be set at \$800 for the Summer Village of Ma-Me-O Beach for a total of \$14,913 in 2022.
