## Highway 13A Construction

### Highway 13A near the Summer Village of Ma-Me-O Beach

#### Overview

During the spring/summer of 2023, Alberta Transportation and Economic Corridors will begin paving on Highway 13A from Highway 13 near the Summer Village of Ma-Me-O Beach, southeast of Pigeon Lake. The project will include milling and paving.

#### Project Details

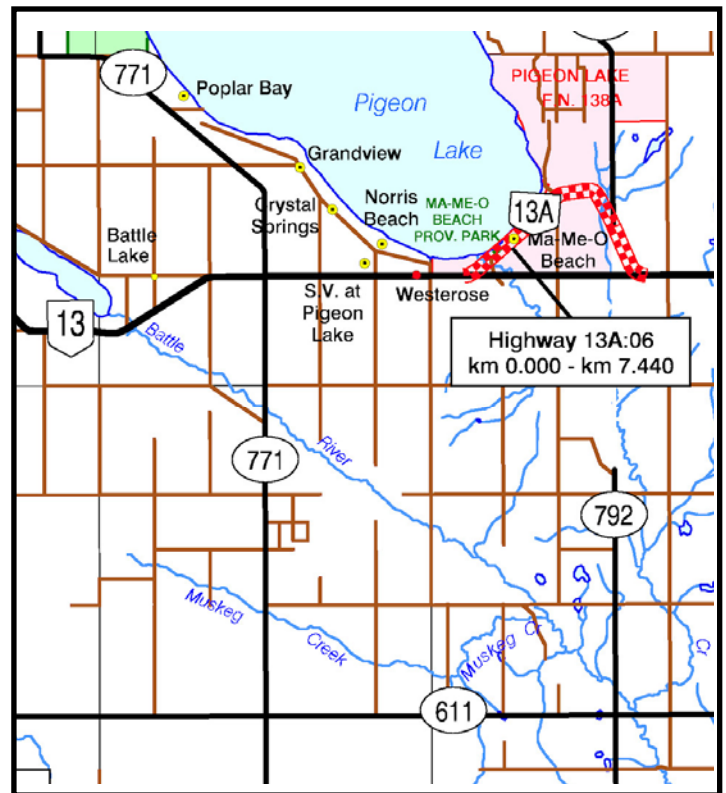
The project includes 7.5 kilometres of paving on Highway 13A from Highway 13. Work is scheduled to begin after the May long weekend and is expected to be completed by September of 2023, weather permitting.

Construction will include milling of existing pavement and re-paving as well as other minor work including culverts, guardrail, high tension cable barrier, rumble strips and highway signage.

Construction activities are scheduled to take place from approximately 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. 7 days a week.

#### Traffic Impacts

As with any construction project, travelers may experience speed reductions, lane closures and minor delays. Signage with additional information on construction timing will be posted on site a week before construction begins. No detours are anticipated. A Traffic Accommodation Strategy is also in place to mitigate the impacts to travelers. This includes additional signage, delineation, and if required, illumination.
